

February SOAR Minutes

February 14, 2017

The meeting was called to order by President Jerry Redington at 1:30 and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call of officers was taken by Wayne Komprood in Susan Walt's absence. Secretary Susan Walt and Trustee Joe Coates were absent.

Wayne Komprood read the minutes of the last meeting and with no alterations or corrections they stood as read.

Geri Hendren read the Treasurer's report and it stood as read.

Jerry Redington informed the group that at the March meeting we will have the past president of the Union City, TN Local Union as a guest speaker, speaking on asbestos in the tire plants. If there is enough interest they will test us to see if we have any asbestos or asbestosis in our lungs at a later date. All hourly, salary, current and former employees are encouraged to attend. You need both of these 1099 forms to file your taxes; if you threw it away you will need to go about getting another 1099.

Don Hill gave an overview of negotiations and how they were going. Sounded like Titan is dragging their feet.

We had a discussion on holding a raffle of a picture that was posted at the plant for the sale of the KS truck banks. Geri Hendren is going to check on getting a permit and we hope to make final arrangements for the raffle at next month's meeting. All proceeds from the raffle would go to various charities.
